Setbacks: [Not specified]	Setbacks: A dock, group moorage facility or swimming platform shall be setback: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) 5.0 metres from the side parcel line boundaries of a parcel adjoining the foreshore of the lake, as projected onto the foreshore and water; or ii) 0.0 metres when a dock, group moorage facility or swimming platform is shared between two adjacent parcels and centered along side parcel line boundary, as projected onto the foreshore and water.
