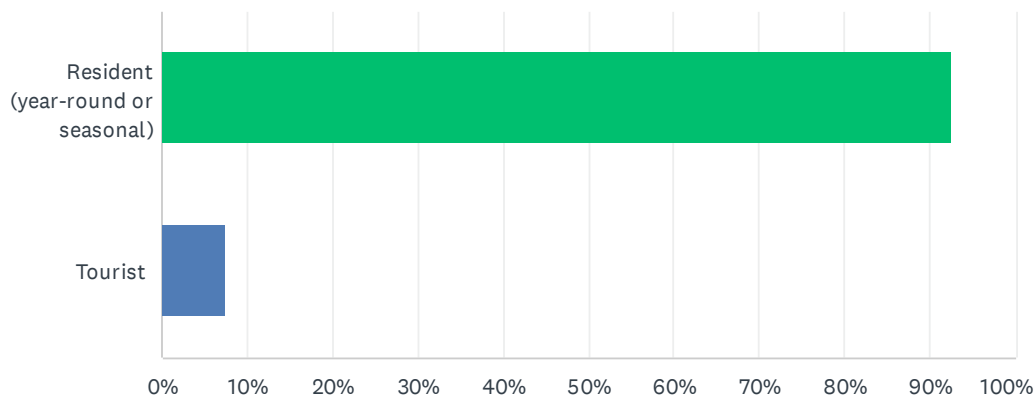


Q1 Are you a resident, or a tourist?

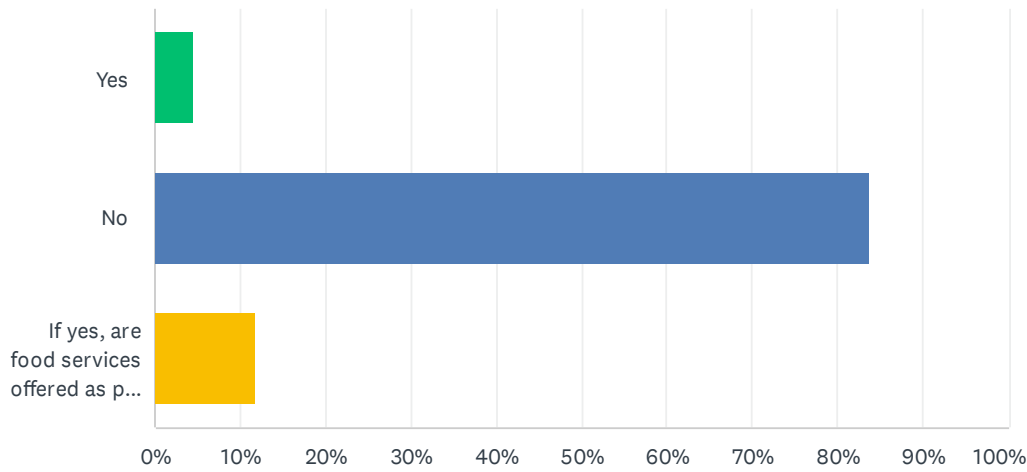

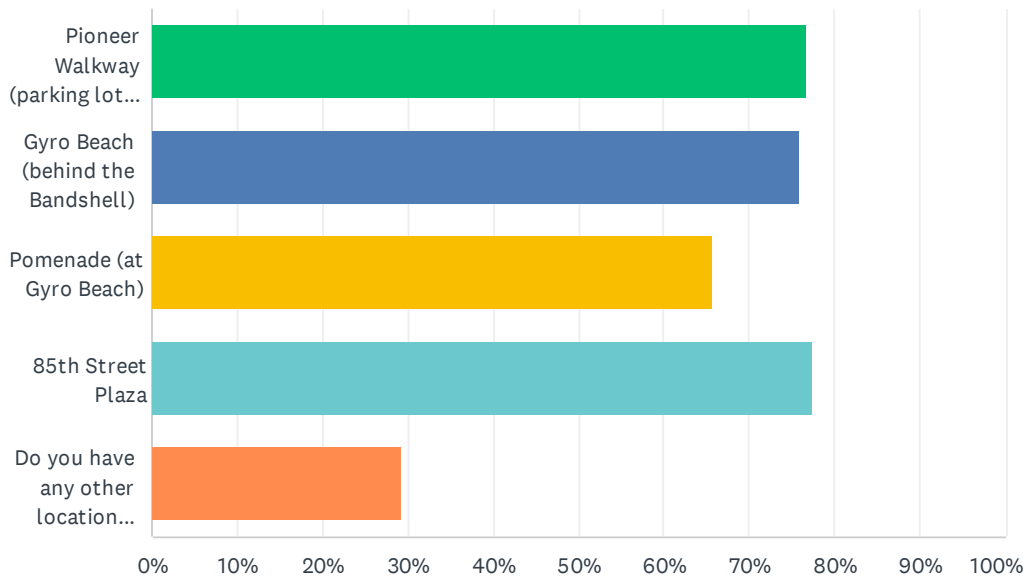
