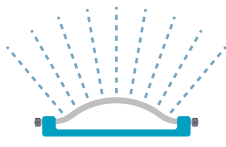


Effective May 1, 2026 the Town & Rural Water Districts 8 & 9 are currently on Stage 2 Water Restrictions

Zone Three: Wednesday | Sunday



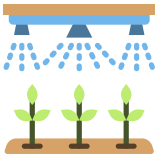
Manual Sprinklers

Between 6:00 AM - 10:00 AM
and 7:00 PM - 12:00 AM



Automatic Timed Sprinklers

Between 12:00 AM - 4:00 AM



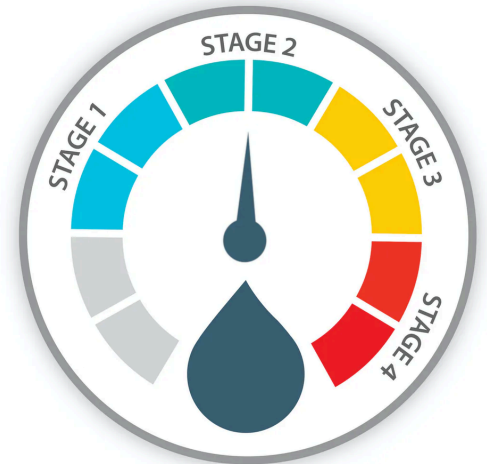
Micro-Jet / Drip Irrigation

Any day between 7:00 PM - 10:00 AM



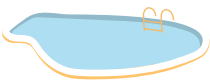
Handheld Sprinkling

Potted Plants: Any day between 6:00 AM - 10:00 AM & 7:00 PM - 12:00 PM
In-Ground Plants: 3 days per week between 6:00 AM - 10:00 AM & 7:00 PM - 12:00 AM



New Sod & Seeded Lawns

Watering Permit Required: **No Permits given between April 30 - Sept 1**
Follow watering instructions from supplier. Watering permit exempts sod for 2 weeks after installation and newly seeded lawns for 6 weeks



Pools, Garden Ponds, Water Fountains & Features

Filling/ Refilling allowed between 6:00 AM - 10:00 AM & 7:00 PM - 12:00 PM 2x/ Week on your zone days. **Topping up only from July 15 - August 31**



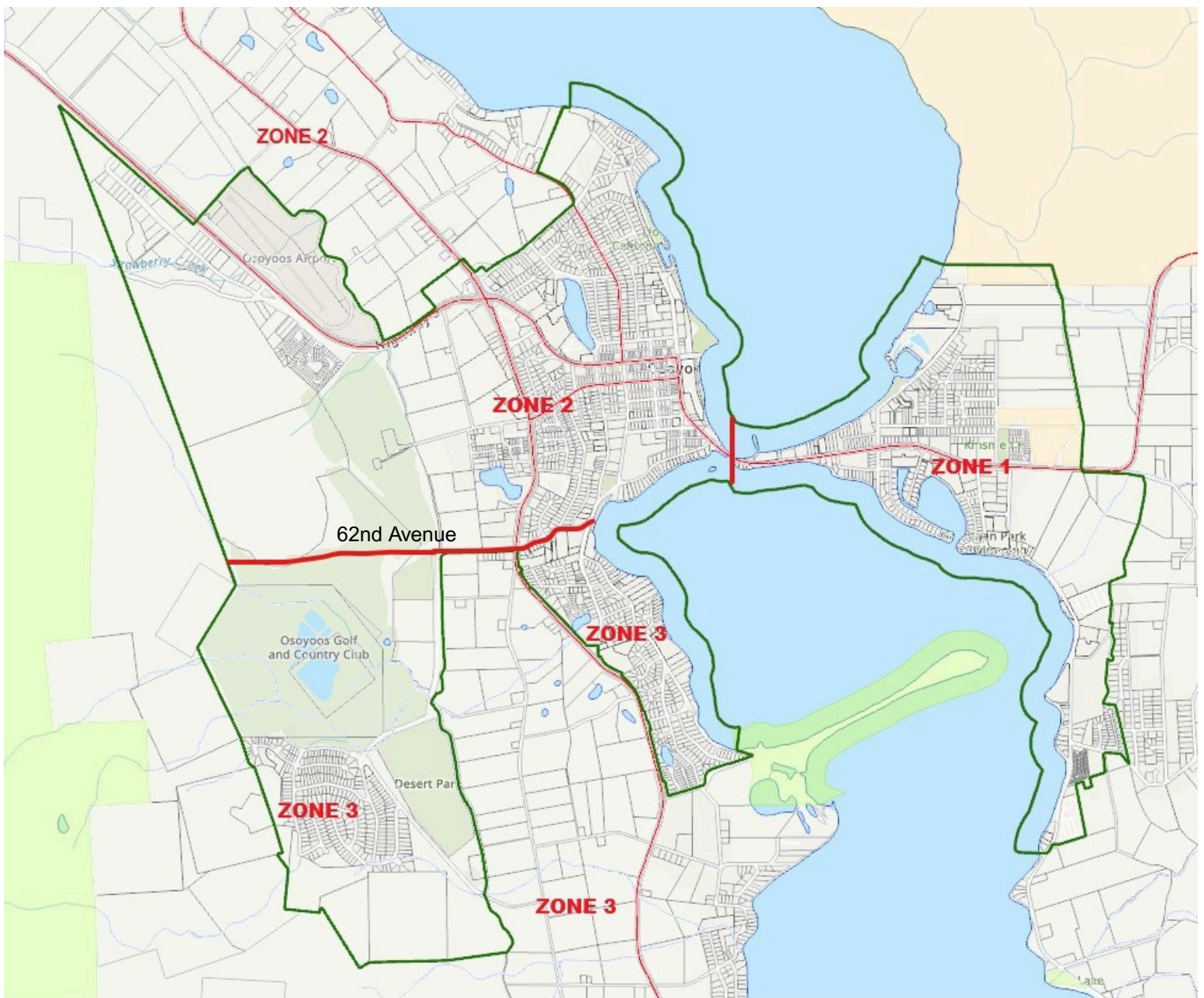
Outdoor Surfaces (driveways, sidewalks, decks, patios, artificial turf)

Wash with spring loaded nozzle for health and safety reasons only



Vehicles (boats/automobile/ATV) Washing

Bucket, sponge & spring loaded nozzle. Or visit a waterwise carwash



Zone 1: All properties east of the bridge over Osoyoos Lake, extending to the northern, southern and eastern municipal boundaries

Zone 2: All properties west of the bridge over Osoyoos Lake, south to include the north side of 62 Avenue, and extending to the western and northern municipal boundaries.

Includes Rural Water District System 8: rural properties to the north of town boundaries.

Zone 3: Properties south of 62 Avenue, including the south side of 62 Avenue and extending to the western and southern municipal boundaries, including properties at the golf course.

Includes Rural Water District System 9: rural properties to the south of town boundaries, south to the US border.
