



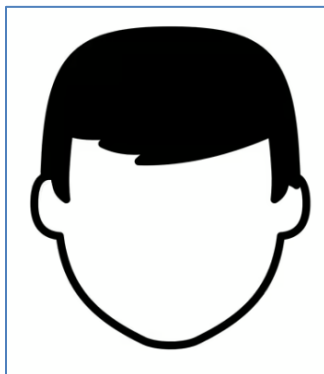
Profile information for all candidates will be published by the Town of Osoyoos

The Town of Osoyoos will use the Candidate Profile information to produce an all-candidates guide. The information will be published on the Town's website to assist voters in knowing their candidates. Provision of this information is not mandatory, but highly recommended so that all candidates are represented in the guide.

Please provide the following two pieces of information electronically, by email, to the Chief Election Officer arobinson@osoyoos.ca no later than **4:00 pm, Friday, September 11, 2026**. No candidate profile information will be accepted or altered after that date and time, as we go to production of the guide.

- ✓ **Information about yourself and your views in under 150 words.** Information in excess of 150 words will be truncated at the end of the last sentence before the 150 word mark, so please keep your submission to under 150 words.
- ✓ **A digital picture of yourself, focusing on your face.** For continuity, electronic images will be cropped or reduced to a common "passport" sized image of each candidate's face in the newsletter, so an image with good resolution and clarity is best.
